The annual school district budget vote and school board member election is held on the third Tuesday in May. Registered voters may vote on the school budget for the 2019-2020 school year and on Board of Education members. Three (3) seats are up for election (seats currently held by Greg Riley, John Cody, and John Curzio). The seats are for three-year terms from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022 and will be filled by the candidates who receive the most votes.




